How to read eBooks in your computer or tablet's web browser using *OverDrive Read*.

You can borrow <u>OverDrive Read eBooks</u> from your library and read them directly in your browser. *Note: Not all eBooks in the library's collection are available in this format.*

What you need

- A valid BCLS library card and PIN (You must be a resident of Bay County)
- An <u>HTML5 capable browser</u> for OverDrive Read (*i.e. Google Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, Safari*)

Borrowing titles

- 1. Open the BCLS digital website at http://baycountylibrary.lib.overdrive.com
- 2. Find an <u>available title</u> to borrow. You can:
 - Click a title from the home page
 - Use the menu at the top of the page to browse categories
 - Run a search
- 3. Click on a title, then click **Borrow** to check it out. If prompted, sign in.
