



Downloading Bay County Library System eBooks to Your Nook

- Before beginning, make sure you have downloaded the free **Adobe Digital Editions** software onto your computer. See separate instruction sheet for assistance.
- This software is necessary to download and manage digital content, as well as read or transfer content to a portable eReader device such as the Nook.
- Also, note that while you may be able to purchase books directly from Barnes & Noble and wirelessly download them to your Nook, **library eBooks require a computer to checkout, download and transfer to your Nook.**

1. Find an available eBook. You can do a digital quick search:

Be sure to choose either the **Adobe EPUB** eBook or the **Adobe PDF** eBook. Do **NOT** choose Kindle format.

(Adobe EPUB eBooks have reflowable text, which means that you can change the font, resize the text, or alter the size of your display and the text of the Adobe EPUB eBook 'reflows' to fill the screen. This makes Adobe EPUB eBooks the optimal choice for reading eBooks on small screens. While some PDFs are reflowable on some devices, one of the main strengths of the PDF format is its ability to preserve the layout of complex documents.)

3. You will see the eBook in your cart. You can continue browsing to add additional titles, or to download your selection, click on **Proceed to Checkout**.





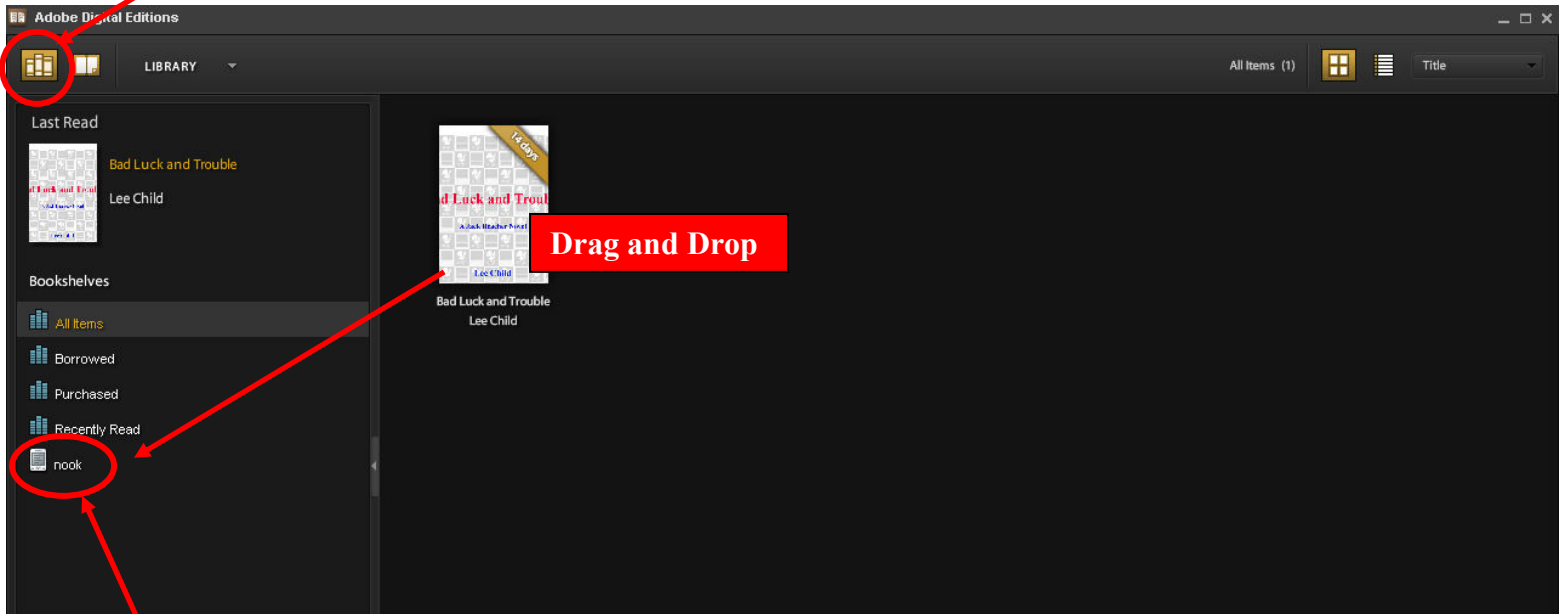

- Adobe Digital Editions will open and download your eBook. Plug your Nook into your computer using the USB cable. (If this is the first time you have used your Nook with Adobe Digital Editions, a Device Setup Assistant will open. Choose **Authorize Device**.)

9. Click on the bookshelf icon in the top left corner to look at the **Library View**.



Your Nook should show up in the column on the left side of the screen. Your downloaded eBook(s) will show up on the right. To complete the transfer of the eBook to your Nook, drag and drop the desired eBook from the right side of the screen onto the Nook icon. This will copy the file onto your device.

10. Disconnect the Nook from your computer. **To do this properly, click on the green arrow at the bottom right corner of the task bar.**



Click the message that appears, and safely disconnect your Nook.
