- Leave feeders up through both migrations. Migrants follow locals !
- Add feeders
- Seed Variety
- Brushpile
- Nest Boxes
- Listen
- Water

# Bird Watching Responsibilities

- Keep Feeders clean. Wash or rotate every two to three weeks. Dawn Detergent.
- No Beef Suet over 50 degrees.
- Prevent window strikes. Feeders within 10 feet of windows. Use decals.
- Do not use water from a garden hose. (PVC's)
- Clean under feeders.
- Please keep cats inside.

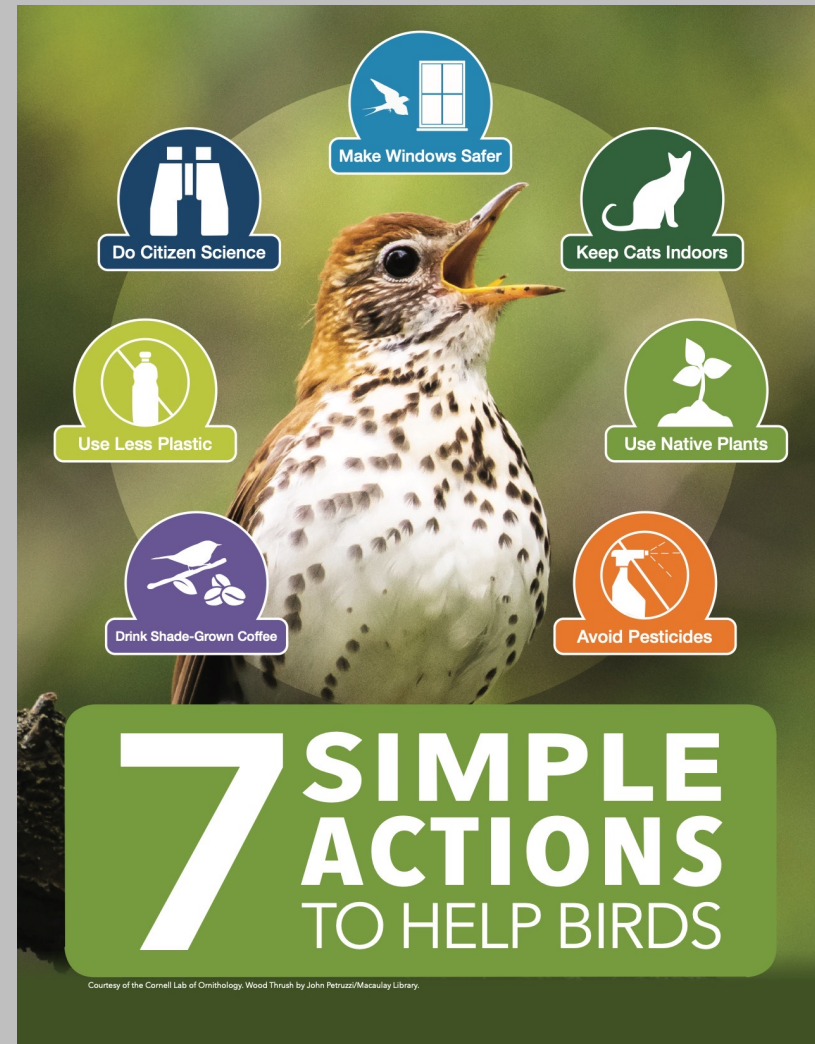
# 7 Simple Actions to Help Birds
