You must be a Bay County Resident to be eligible for the prize drawing. Passports are valid October 1, 2025 to May 31, 2026.

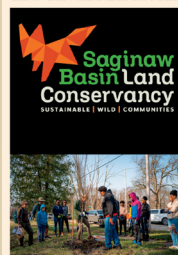



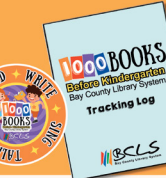
